

YEAR 7 – 2020

FAIRFIELD HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Fairfield High School will be offering **six** scholarships in 2020 to Year 7 students. The scholarships will be awarded to students who are experiencing financial hardship or disadvantage but have demonstrated excellence and consistent progress in *academic studies*.

Scholarships will be awarded as follows:

- to six YEAR 7 students in 2020 at Fairfield High School
- \$500 over the two years to assist their progress through Years 7 and 8 at Fairfield High School
- Funds may be spent on school contributions, uniform, excursions, and other resources deemed necessary to support their schooling

GENERAL SELECTION PROCESS AND CONDITIONS

A panel comprising of the Head Teacher Enrichment, and Principal or Deputy Principal, will examine all applications in line with the selection criteria. Successful applicants will be notified in writing in Term 3. The scholarship will be awarded from Term 3 2020 until the end of Year 8 in 2021.

Funds will be kept in trust at the school for all scholarship holders. Should the student fail to follow the school's Code of Conduct, attend regularly or meet the requirements of their course then the scholarship will be forfeited. Should the student not expend all the funds at the end of the **two years** then the remaining balance will be awarded to them in a cheque.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Experiences financial hardship and/or disadvantage
- Demonstrates high achievement and progress in academic studies
- Maintains regular and consistent attendance
- Demonstrates commitment to the values of the school community

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:

- A supporting statement from a teacher, outlining the students' suitability for the scholarship and how they meet the selection criteria, in no more than 500 words
- A statement from the applicant explaining why he/she should receive this scholarship and how he/she would use it to improve their schooling, in no more than 500 words
- Copy of the Year 7 academic report (Semester 1)
- Copies of any other relevant supporting documentation (awards, certificates, etc.)

Do not include original copies of documents as the school will not be responsible for them or their return.

All supporting statements should be **word processed** not hand written. Applications should be presented in a **plastic A4 display folder** so they can be easily read by the panel and pages cannot be misplaced.

Applications are due to the Principal by 3pm on Friday 31st July 2020.
