FAIRFIELD HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION FORM

Fairfield High School will be offering **four** scholarships in 2020 to Fairfield High School students **currently in Year 8** who will be entering Year 9 in 2021. The scholarships will be awarded to students who are experiencing financial hardship or disadvantage but have demonstrated excellence and consistent progress in **academic studies**.

Scholarships will be awarded as follows:

- to **four YEAR 8** students starting **Year 9 in 2021** at Fairfield High School
- **\$500** over the **two years** to assist their progress **through Years 9 and 10** at Fairfield High School
- **Funds may be spent on** school contributions, uniform, excursions, and other resources deemed necessary to support their schooling

GENERAL SELECTION PROCESS AND CONDITIONS

A panel comprising of the Year Adviser, Head Teacher Enrichment, and Principal or Deputy Principal, will examine all applications in line with the selection criteria. Successful applicants will be notified in writing at the beginning of term 4. The scholarship will be awarded from **Term 1 2021 and the funds may be used until the end of Year 10**.

Funds will be kept in trust at the school for all scholarship holders. Should the student fail to follow the school's Code of Conduct, attend regularly or meet the requirements of their course then the scholarship will be forfeited.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Experiences financial hardship and/or disadvantage
- Demonstrates high achievement and progress in academic studies
- Maintains regular and consistent attendance
- Demonstrates commitment to the values of the school community

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:

- A supporting statement **from a teacher**, outlining why they believe the student should receive the scholarship (no more than 500 words)
- A statement **from the applicant** outlining their suitability for the scholarship, how they meet the selection criteria and how he/she would use it to improve their schooling (no more than 500 words)
- Copies of the **Year 7 and 8** academic reports
- Any other supporting documentation (e.g. certificates / awards)

Do not include original copies of documents as the school will not be responsible for them or their return.

All supporting statements should be **word processed**, not hand written. Applications should be presented in a **plastic A4 display folder** so they can be easily read by the panel and pages cannot be misplaced.

Applications are due to the Principal by 3pm on Friday 4th September 2020.
